- ❖ Aus/NZ Ethics progression
 - Australia: 11/19 sites completed governance and full executed DTA
 - NZ: National ethics achieved, 7 NZ sites getting locality approval
- Asia: PMCC will have individual agreements with Asian centres
- Canada: PMCC will directly sponsor two Canadian sites
- Europe: Pending outcome from Data Protection review

REDCap and beta testing

- REDCap database has been tested and revised three times. It has been uploaded onto PMCC server and in its final stage of development
- Site coordinators will need to obtain PI INSTITUTIONAL EMAILS for REDCap authorization with PMCC (NOT GAMIL/HOTMAIL etc)
- ❖ Beta testing will aim to be COMPLETED by the **END OF APRIL**
